












Welcome to our beautiful city – a premier destination to live, work, play and invest in!

Our City Council, or governing body, plays a vital role in shaping the future of Warman. They provide leadership, establish policies, and make key decisions that impact the daily lives of residents. By working together, council members determine which services are offered and ensure they are delivered efficiently and effectively.

Warman is governed by a City Council consisting of the mayor and six councillors, each elected to serve a four-year term. The current council is in office from 2024 to 2028. Their responsibilities include overseeing important services such as bylaws, road maintenance, water and sewer systems, snow and waste removal, economic development, recreation facilities and programs, and crime and fire prevention, among others.

Business licenses are administered on a yearly basis, with license renewals occurring in January of every year. Applications can be printed off from warman.ca/789 (or picked up from City Hall), filled out then dropped off at City Hall along with payment.


Priority 1 roads are cleared first, followed by Priority 2 roads. Residential streets are addressed as time permits. View the Priority Road Map at warman.ca/556.

If no choice is made, it defaults to PSSD. Education tax makes up slightly more than one-third of your total property tax.

#### ZANE DMYTRYSHYN PARK



Centennial Park, named for Saskatchewan's centennial, is a hidden gem west of the 400 block of Crystal Spring Drive. With picnic tables, benches, and a modern play structure with safe surfacing, it's a perfect spot for kids!

#### **BROOKLYN PARK**

Bring your little ones to this charming park on Brooklyn Crescent, where they can enjoy a play structure designed for active fun. The park also features toddler swings, making it an ideal spot for younger children to play and spend quality time outdoors!

Grab some friends and play a round of disc golf. It's free to play, and there's no need to book ahead, but you'll need to bring your own discs. #### **RICK UNGER PARK**

Rick Unger Park is in the picturesque Legends area on Player Crescent, just west of The Legends Golf Course. It features picnic tables, park benches, and swings that kids will love as well as an exciting CSA-certified play structure providing a safe and fun experience for children of all ages.

#### LINDA SCHAEFER PARK

#### LARRY NELSON PARK & LARRY ERBER PARK

These parks are perfect for when you want to go for a run or walk, with park benches for breaks along the way. This long, linear park space stretches from Ballesteros to Snead Crescents.

#### **WALTER DAVIS PARK**

Walter Davis Park is located off Augusta Boulevard or Palmer Crescent. It features a walking path, park bench and a view of The Legends Golf Course.



Prairie Oasis Park has two playgrounds: one near the gazebo on Industrial Drive, and an accessible playground on the other side of the park behind the campground entrance, along 3rd Avenue South. Endless entertainment!



#### **DIAMOND BMX TRACK**

The Diamond BMX Track is one of the top tracks in Canada and is used for competitive BMX biking and national competitions. This world-renowned track was designed by BMX Olympian Trent Jones and holds the first and only paved berms/corners in Saskatchewan.

#### **OUTDOOR ARENA**

Lace up your skates for a game of shinny or practice your double lutz at this fantastic 75x175 outdoor arena. It is equipped with lights, a zamboni, a warmup room and washroom making it the perfect spot for winter fun.

#### **PRAIRIE OASIS CAMPGROUND**

Next to the pond is the beautiful 25 stall RV campground. Open for the season from May to the end of September, all sites are electrified, have water, a picnic table, and a campfire pit (wood not provided). There are washrooms and free showers on site.

#### ÉCOLE WARMAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL



#### DIAMOND HILL PARK SOCCER PITCH

4th Street West

The southwest corner of Diamond Hill Park contains an irrigated soccer pitch for younger age groups with no spectator seating. A portable washroom is available.

#### PERCY HOFF SOCCER PITCH

4th Street West

Across from École Warman Elementary School, Percy Hoff soccer pitch is irrigated but has no spectator seating, Washrooms are available at the outdoor arena.



#### RINK EXPANSION – SECOND ICE SURFACE

Construction on the second ice surface at the Warman Communiplex is expected to be completed in time for hockey season this fall. With 2,952  $\rm m^2$  on the main floor and 880  $\rm m^2$  on the second floor, it will include seating for 205 people and six change rooms, as well as a second-floor lounge space seating up to 150.

This expansion represents a strategic investment in the city's recreational infrastructure, aiming to meet the needs of a growing population and support the development of local sports programs, including the addition of an SJHL team, and will have a positive impact on Warman's local economy by attracting more events and visitors to the area.





#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

The Warman Senior Drop-in Centre is one of Warman's most historic buildings. Constructed between 1905 and 1907, it originally served as the community's train station for the Canadian Northern Railway and later the Canadian National Railway until 1942, when it was relocated.

An excellent example of early railway architecture in rural Saskatchewan, the station officially closed in the 1980s and was relocated again. Its interior was renovated, and the exterior restored, transforming it into the senior drop-in centre. In 2004, it was designated a Municipal Heritage Property.



# **Emergency Services**

Warman Fire Rescue, RCMP, and Medavie Health Services work together to protect lives and property, ensuring public safety in Warman and area.

#### Warman Fire Rescue

Warman Fire Rescue is a mostly volunteer service, responding to fire, medical, and rescue calls within Warman and the R.M. of Corman Park. Operating from the Fire Hall on 4th Street and Centennial Blvd, it is the busiest volunteer department in the province and has mutual aid agreements with Martensville, Osler, Dalmeny and Langham. Only the Fire Chief and Deputy Fire Chief positions are full-time.

Warman Fire Rescue is a proactive department with equipment and training equal to all full-time career fire departments with 30 members who carry radios at home and respond 24/7/365. It has mutual aid agreements with Martensville, Osler, Dalmeny and Langham. In 2024, the department handled 489 emergency calls, including 119 fire, rescue, and motor vehicle incidents, and 370 medical responses. Equipped and trained to full-time standards, Warman Fire Rescue collaborates with nearby communities and participates in a regional fire training facility.

# **Bylaw Enforcement**

Warman's Civic Bylaws are important to ensure a clean, safe, and orderly community. The Bylaw Enforcement Office enforces these regulations promptly and courteously.

Our bylaws are local municipal regulations that are decided upon by Warman City Council, and enforced by our Bylaw Enforcement Office. Duties of our bylaw officer includes animal control, responding to inquiries and complaints from the public, educating residents about local bylaws, issuing and processing violation tickets for bylaw infractions, and cooperating with local agencies as needed (the Bylaw Enforcement Office does not deal with Criminal Code offenses). Our bylaw office maintains community standards



and public safety. You should call Bylaw Enforcement to report missing or found animals, report an unsightly property, make a parking complaint, or if you have any concerns regarding any Warman bylaw. To view the City of Warman bylaws, go to warman.ca/99.

#### **Some Common Bylaws:**

Pets must be licensed to help reunite owners with lost pets and track household pet numbers. Licenses cost \$25 for a pet's lifetime and are available at the Warman Communiplex.

ATV's are prohibited from operating within Warman's city limits. Snowmobiles are permitted (if licensed) to travel along the most direct route in or out of Warman, to or from your home. However, there are several streets that prohibit snowmobile traffic: 6th Avenue S., Central St., Centennial and Clubhouse Boulevards – snowmobilers can only cross these streets when they are leaving or entering the city. Snowmobiling is not permitted in or through any of Warman's parks.

RV's are permitted to park along local streets for a maximum of 48 hours attached or unattached, to load or unload.

### **EOC - Emergency Response Centre**

Warman's Emergency Measures Organization, comprised of a trained group of City staff, council members, and volunteers, manages emergencies and disasters affecting the city. Based at the fire hall, its 24/7 emergency operations center can be staffed within minutes. warman.ca/139

### **Warman Evacuation Centre**

### Waste & Recycling

All Warman households participate in Loraas Disposal Services Ltd. curbside recycling and waste programs, with the option of a curbside organics program.

Each household is supplied with a recycling and garbage cart with collection alternating weeks. Carts must be rolled out by **7 am** on collection day, and not overfilled. Loraas Recycling brochures are available at Warman City Hall or see warman.ca/834 or loraas.ca.



### **Garbage - Black Cart**

Only solid, non-hazardous waste materials including general household garbage, food, yard and garden waste, etc is permitted. Hazardous waste, medical waste, pressure-filled containers, paint, used oil or containers, or electronics cannot be placed in the cart. Some of these items can be disposed of at SARCAN or at the Warman Household Hazardous Waste Day on October 4, 2025.

### **Recycling - Blue Cart**

The recycling program is a single stream recycling program, meaning items do not need to be sorted by the resident. Items that can be recycled are cardboard and boxboard, mixed paper, #1 to #7 plastics, household tin and aluminum. Any other waste is not acceptable in the blue cart.

### **Organics - Green Bin**

The optional Curbside Organics Compost Service is a convenient and affordable way to dispose of fruits, vegetables and plant matter. The fee is \$10 per month added to your City of Warman utility bill for May 1 to October 31. To subscribe: warman.ca/834.


### MARTENSVILLE-WARMAN EARLY YEARS FAMILY RESOURCE CENTRE

Our city was named after Cy Warman to honour his association with railroads and his contributions to literature that celebrated the railway industry.

Cy Warman (1855-1914) was an American-Canadian journalist, author, and poet known as the "Poet Laureate of the Rockies." He wrote extensively about the lives of railroad workers and the development of railroads, which played a vital role in shaping Western Canada. Born in Greenup, Illinois, he grew up on a homestead granted to his father for service in the Mexican War. With limited formal education, he began working at age five as a water boy for a railroad construction crew. Later, he considered becoming a wheat buyer but lost almost everything in a market crash. After several failed ventures. Warman moved to Colorado in 1880, where he worked planting orchards and later in a smelter plant.

During Colorado's railroad boom, Warman was drawn to railroading. He joined the Denver & Rio Grande as a labourer, quickly earning a promotion to fireman. Within three years, he became a locomotive engineer. Due to health reasons. Warman had to give up the railroad work physically, but his passion for it in mind and spirit endured. Though his time as an engineer was brief, his experiences during this period gave him a future livelihood recounting the noises, smells, humour and romance of railroading.

Warman began writing poems and stories about railroad life. In 1888, Warman became editor of the publication Western Railway. He sold his interest in Western Railway in March 1892 and relocated to bustling Creede, Colorado where he co-founded the Creede Chronicle during the height of the region's silver boom. The town rapidly grew from a handful of residents to 10,000, attracting miners, gamblers, businessmen, and infamous outlaws. Warman's newspaper earned a reputation for honesty and truth, with Warman advocating for law and order in a lawless frontier town. The City of Creede, Colorado, Warman's "sister city," continues to honour Cy Warman's legacy.

After riding from New York City to Chicago in the cab of locomotive, he wrote a railroad story. A Thousand Miles in a Night for McClure's Magazine in 1892. This was the first of a series of widely popular True Tales of the Railroad articles written for McClure's, gaining Warman national recognition. His writings caught the attention of the New York Sun, who began to publish his work,

including the hit poem Sweet Marie, inspired by his second wife. This poem was set to music by Raymon Moore and became a popular success in 1893 (and was later featured in the 1947 film Life With Father). One of his notable works. Tales Of An Engineer: With Rhymes Of The Rail (1895), is a collection of poems and stories capturing the rhythm and energy of the railroads and those who worked on them. Along with authoring 17 books, he was a regular contributor to magazines like The Youth's Companion and Harper's Weekly, where his vivid depictions of Western life and the rugged and adventurous spirit of railroaders and the landscapes they traversed captured readers' imaginations. His literary contributions earned him a respected place in early Western American literature.

Warman and his wife lived in New York, Washington for several years from where they travelled Europe, the Far East, and Alaska, settling in 1899 in London, Ontario, where he did consulting and writing work for the Grand Trunk Railway. Around 1904, Western Canada experienced a railway construction boom, with the Canadian Northern rail line expanding across the western territories. Warman travelled with the rail crews, writing about the rail line expansion which helped encourage immigration to the newly-formed provinces of Saskatchewan and Alberta.

On April 11, 1914, Cy Warman died in Chicago after suffering a stroke that left him paralyzed and ill for several months.

In 1905, the settlement initially known as "Diamond," named for the diamond-shaped intersection of the Grand Trunk and Canadian Pacific railway lines, was renamed Warman. This name honoured Cy Warman, recognizing the city's origins as a railway hub and its deep connection to the rail system.

### Will the Lights Be White?

Oft, when I feel my engine swerve, As o'er strange rails we fare, I strain my eye around the curve For what awaits us there. When swift and free she carries me Through yards unknown at night, I look along the line to see That all the lamps are white. The blue light marks the crippled car, The green light signals slow; The red light is a danger light, The white light, "Let her go." Again the open fields we roam, And, when the night is fair, I look up in the starry dome And wonder what's up there. For who can speak for those who dwell Behind the curving sky? No man has ever lived to tell Just what it means to die. Swift toward life's terminal I trend, The run seems short tonight; God only knows what's at the end – I hope the lamps are white.

Cy Warman married his first wife, Ida Blanche Hays, in 1879 and they had one daughter, Charlotte in 1881. Ida died in childbirth (as did the baby) in 1887. Cy married his second wife, Myrtle Marie Jones, in 1892. They had three sons: Dana Cy, born in 1894, Bryan in 1896, and Robert in 1897, and a daughter, Vonda Marie, in 1899. (Vonda, Saskatchewan is named after her.)

### **History of Warman**

Warman boasts a vibrant history rooted in the construction of the railway lines. It has weathered various challenges such as tornadoes, droughts, epidemics, and beyond. Despite these adversities, it has flourished to become the vibrant, modern community it is today.

The Village of Warman was incorporated in 1906, but it actually had its beginning two years earlier, in 1904, when the Canadian Northern Railway (a predecessor of Canadian National Railway) was built from Humboldt to North Battleford. The railway tracks were built parallel to the Dominion Telegraph line originally built in 1876. Warman was located at the intersection of the new east-west CN line and the existing north-south Canadian Pacific Railway line from Regina to Prince Albert.

in the new community. The railways, newspapers and government encouraged settlement, and Warman soon became a bustling village with a large school, churches, a bank, two hotels, a newspaper, a blacksmith shop, a shoe repair shop, several general stores and even wooden sidewalks. The surrounding rural municipality was also named Warman.



The original settlement was informally called "Diamond" because of the diamond shape made by the intersecting railway tracks. The name of the settlement was

soon changed to Warman in honour of Cy Warman, a journalist, author and poet who worked as a publicity writer for Canadian Northern and the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway documenting the railway expansion boom in western Canada. There was a large influx of settlers into the area following the construction of the new railway, lured by the promise of a quarter section of farmland for \$10, and also by the business opportunities





While the railroads were the new town's biggest asset, Warman was handicapped by its lack of a good source of water and also suffered a number of setbacks, including a devastating fire in 1908. A tornado in 1910 also took its toll, as did numerous epidemics of diseases like mumps, measles, chicken pox and scarlet fever. Competition was keen from the nearby city of Saskatoon, and many business people who had lost their buildings to natural disasters chose to rebuild in Saskatoon.

After its promising start, the Village of Warman's population declined in the aftermath of World War I and by 1927 Warman had dropped to unincorporated hamlet status with a population of fewer than 100 people. The community's administrative affairs were handled by the Rural Municipality of Warman. The RM of Warman continued to grow, and by 1932 was the most densely-populated and prosperous of any in Saskatchewan, largely due to the close-knit Mennonite villages in the area. The RM of Warman merged with the RM of Cory and RM of Park in the early 1970s to create the RM of Corman Park. In the 1950s, the community of Warman began to grow again as a result of improvements in transportation. One of the first "bedroom communities" in the province, residents of Warman began to commute to jobs in Saskatoon while raising their families in the small village

By 1961, the population of Warman had grown to 659 residents, and in 1962, it reincorporated as a village. By 1966, Warman was granted town status. Major improvements followed, including treated water piped in from Saskatoon, the installation of storm sewers and paving of streets.



Warman officially became the 16th municipality in Saskatchewan to become a city on October 24, 2012. From there, Warman has become the face of growth among cities in the province. Warman's population was 7084 in 2012. The population soared over the next decade, and Warman is now the eighth-largest city in Saskatchewan with a population of over 13,700.
